Drop-off Procedure

If your child takes the bus:

- In the morning, the bus will collect your child at the allocated time as indicated by STS.
- You must take your child to the meeting point and wait with them until they are on the bus.
- Please contact the bus nanny if your child is unwell and cannot attend school due to illness.

If you drop your child at school:

- Entrance to the school begins at 7:30am.
- You must say goodbye to them outside the appropriate entrance, where they will enter the school.
- Please allow extra time at the start of the school year to accommodate road works and increased traffic. Your children don't like to be late for school.

























Collection Procedure

If your child takes the bus:

- Your child will board their bus with all the other students at the end of school at 2:30pm
- You must be at the collection point to meet your child at the allocated time.

If you pick your child up from school:

- The collection point for Years 3-11 will be from the Multi-Purpose Hall. The doors open for parents at 2:40pm. Please do follow the one-way system as you wall around the MPH.
- Please ensure the adult collecting your child is a named contact on our system and wears their Parent lanyard. This will be requested upon collection by your child's teacher.


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Thank you for being on time
